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SCHOOL DETAILS

The Manthan School is a private, independent school. We are a co-educational, secular school offering an alternative model of education. We are firmly committed to providing a student-centered, developmentally-appropriate learning environment that is active in responding to the unique needs of each student. To achieve this aim we have different features to offer.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The Master Plan of the 2.5 acres institution campus has been developed keeping in mind universal design principles so as to allow a barrier-free access in the vicinity. Being a Mahagun venture, the school building is environment friendly and intents to create a holistic ambiance with greens in harmony with the eco-friendly environment. Intermediate gardens, indoor green play areas, free-flow circulations, interesting play of spaces and light - our modern design built-up provides an aesthetically pleasing and hence motivating environment for the students. Our classrooms are large, air conditioned and well lit with the smart and interactive learning techniques.

The school contains four blocks namely: Administrative, Pre Primary, Secondary and Recreational. These blocks have been strategically located to ensure minimum interferences in respective functions and facilities. We understand that the needs and requirements of the Pre Primary and Secondary Schools are different and thus they have been designed in such a way that both the zones do not collide or overlap each other.

Classrooms

Our Classroom focuses on individualized/personalized attention and care to build strong base of compassion and security for the children. The rooms are well ventilated, bright and child friendly with age appropriate furniture. Classrooms are equipped with air conditioning facility. The primary classrooms have different learning corners that focus on individual learners and their strengths. Artists Hub

Art Education is a vital component of childhood development. At Manthan, students are exposed to multiple techniques of art and are a help to focus on developing aesthetic sensibilities. Art teaches children that problems can give more than one solution, and that questions can have more than one answer. A wide range of experience is provided to our students through drawing, painting, sculpture and craftwork. Art education develops creativity and problem-solving skills improves Judgement and shows children that there are multiple perspectives. It teaches students to think through and within the material.

Technology Lab

The Computer Lab is equipped with 70 to 75 numbers of computers, easy access to the Internet and a technology specialist teacher who knows how to navigate and instruct the students in regards to all issues of information, communication and technology. It offers ICT/Media Lit/STEM to all students from K-7 along with their teachers. Manthan creates an aroma of learning for all the students in the Lab, allowing them to build technology specified skills from grade to grade.





Music Studio

Music serves as an aesthetic and an audio experience. This experience basically involves the mind in an appealing way with the help of sounds. No printed communication, discussion or arithmetical calculation! It is an expression by itself. Music is also regarded to be an important part of the curriculum for the role that it plays in understanding different cultures. Music is a true demonstration of traditions, community culture, aspirations and accomplishments of humankind. Music is embedded with the various customs and beliefs of the common man. We have the Indian and Western Music studios that cater to both choral and instrumental music.





Dance Studio

We at the Manthan School believe that dancing is a stress buster. Dancing with

the feet, with ideas, with words and with expressions sets our education at a pace apart.

Our dance studios are fully equipped for Indian and Western dances. They are spacious enough to allow our staff and students to choreograph works for stage performances and competitions.



Theatre

Through theatre/street-plays students are given opportunity to create their own dramas and attend plays presented by others in the society. Student Lockers

Unlike the traditional system, The Manthan school provides well-equipped subject studios and students lockers inculcating the sense of responsibility in our students. Lockers are positioned close to each studio in-order to help student's movements while switching from one studio to another without hampering the routine.



Subject Studios

To encourage the discipline of time management and channelize inherent abilities of young learners, The Manthan has introduced the concept of Studios as a multidisciplinary creative platform. The school has impressive architecturally designed Subject Studios of Math, Science, Social Science and Languages. Learning becomes enriched and meaningful when the learners gain access to different types of teaching aids visible in the studios and are also exposed to technology-aided classes. The studios capture the audio-visual senses of the learners through interactive modules and foster retention and adequate storage of information. The studios are vibrant and colourful with meaningful content displayed on the soft boards. A teacher or facilitator remains stationed in the studio and it is the student who on the contrary moves to attend classes in the respective subject studio.

SCHOOL CULTURE

Our philosophy of education is a student-centered learning approach which is supported by NCLB policy where no student is left behind and from time to time remedial classes are conducted to bring below average students at par with the class. The overall importance is placed on the importance of their physical and emotional progress, which leads to their academic achievement.

The faculty is well equipped with the latest technology, which provides them with a broad spectrum of delivery methods for the curriculum content. The focus is on creating a caring, engaging and a learning environment that is also academically rigorous.

Till Grade 2 we follow mother teacher concept, which helps in a strong understanding of the students. Parents are also offered a regular time of communication with their teachers through messages, mails and ERP. Grade 3 onwards the system is more versatile as the concept of subject teachers begins.

To support the care and safety of each child the school has a well-developed management policy with the objective of fostering a school environment that is safe and productive for all. The school also works on the growth mindset of each and every individual with various workshops and display boards.






